1. ACCOUNTS

To note monthly Accounts for the month of April, 1971.

2. SANITARY REPORT

To consider the Health Report submitted by the Health Officer, Dacca Cantt under section - 129 of the Cantonment Act 1924.

3. EARTH FILLING IN PARK

Reference CBR No 6 dated 12-4-71.

To consider and regularise the cost of filling of earth already incurred for Rs. 6,802/26 in improving Cantonment Park site situated in low lying area on the north of Broadway Building along the main Road in Kurmitola Bazar Area.

The detailed report along with the connected documents are placed on the table.

RESOLUTION: Noted.

RESOLUTION: Considered. The recommendation of the Health Officer be implemented. With a view to eradicating the stray Cattle nuisance in Cantt it has been decided that the individual/party impounding the Cattle in Cantt Board Cattle Pound be remunerated at the following rates :-

- (1) Cow = Ps. 0/50 each
- (2) Calf = Ps. 0/25 "
- (3) Goat = Ps. 0/25 "

RESOLUTION: Considered and approved. Necessary payment to the Contractors be made within this financial year.



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4. TRANSFER OF LEASE-HOLD RIGHT

Reference CBRs No 5 dated 12-1-71 and No 5 dated 12-4-71.

To consider letters dated 25-2-71 and 24-12-70 in respect of Mr Taher Ali lessee of Plot No 43-D Kurmitola Bazar Area, Dacca Cantt requesting the Board to allow him to transfer the lease-hold right of the plot in question to his cousin Mr Sajjad Hossain.

5. GAS INCINERATOR

Reference CBR No 2(b) dated 12-4-71.

To consider the report of M/S Titas in connection with the installation of a GAS INCINERATOR in Cantt for the disposal of rubbish/refuse by burning.

6. OCTROI ESTABLISHMENT

To consider reduction of staff of Octroi Establishment as the collection of Octroi tax has almost come down to NIL.

7. ASSESSMENT LIST

Reference Cantt Board Resolution No 9 dated 12-4-71.

To consider assessment of annual valuation of all new Buildings in Kurmitola Bazar Area as required under section - 66 of Cantonment Act 1924 (II of 1924). All connected papers are placed on the table.

8. SITING BOARD - SWEEPERS COLONY

To consider selection of a SITING BOARD for the siting of Sweepers Colony in Bazar Area land.

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RESOLUTION: Approved. Further one year's time for construction of house be given. If the house is not completed in time, the plot shall be resumed.

RESOLUTION: Considered. A central receptacle for disposal of night soil in the near future be constructed and a case be taken up with WASA for connecting this with their sewer lines.

RESOLUTION: Considered. The Octroi staff be served with fifteen days notice of discharge. The Octroi Inspector, four clerks and two Peons out of total strength of 25 be retained on merit basis. The retrenched staff may, however, be considered for appointment as and when the work load for collection of Octroi is increased.

RESOLUTION: Considered and approved. Notices to the lessees concerned for inviting objections if any be issued.

RESOLUTION: Considered. A recce in Cantt Bazar Areas be done and suitable alternative places be found first.



9. EXTENSION OF CANTT LIMITS

To consider extension of Cantt limit to certain portions of Banani and Mirpur as per plan for health & security reasons.

10. CONSTRUCTION OF MARKET - KACHUKHET, DACCA CANTT

To consider construction of a market in Kachukhet. Brief feasibility report of the CEO is put up.

11. UNAUTHORISED CONSTRUCTION

To consider fixing up procedure for removal of all unauthorised construction within the Cantt limits.

12. BOUNDARY PILLARS

To consider construction of approx. 600 Boundary Pillars around the limits of Dacca Cantonment. The work is estimated at Rs.1,20,000/00 at Rs.200/00 approx. each for which immediate special grant-in-aid would be necessary.

13. RECLASSIFICATION OF LAND

To consider reclassification of land measuring one acre in the Tufail Colony (MES Cffr Colony) for converting it into a park.

14. NON-ATTENDANCE OF CANTT SERVANTS.

To consider disciplinary action against the non-attending Cantt Servants. A detailed report is put up before the Board for consideration.

15. AMENDMENT OF ASSESSMENT



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**RESOLUTION:** Considered and approved. MEO be approached for taking up the case of inclusion of Banani and part of Mirpur within the limits of Dacca Cantt in the light of Section 4(1) of Cantonment Act 1924(Act II of 1924).

**RESOLUTION:** Considered. The project may be offered to Banks for attracting finances other than Govt loan.

**RESOLUTION:** Considered. The residents in Cantt be informed through Public Notices duly circulated in the News papers that they should remove all unauthorised construction by 31st May 1971 positively. Failing compliance the unauthorised construction be removed by the Board at the risk and cost of the owners.

**RESOLUTION:** Considered. The issue of the construction of boundary Pillars be kept pending till the inclusion of new areas within the limits of the Cantt is decided.

**RESOLUTION:** Considered. Due to the paucity of Fund the case be kept pending till the Board is financially sound.

**RESOLUTION:** Considered. The services of all the staff who left the Station without permission and did not turn up to their duties in accordance with ML orders be terminated and fresh appointments be made in their places where necessary.



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16. BUILDING PLAN

To consider the following plans and applications under section 179 of the Cantonments Act, 1924. The plan had been sent for check and technical approval of the Executive Engineer (ME) Dacca Cantt. He had also returned the same after technical checking.

It is certified that there is no breach of lease terms, change of purpose or any encroachment on Govt Land.
