3. To consider letter No. 26/141/G/D-5/LCH dated 4th May 1955 on the subject of setting up ^a small museum in Cantonments with a view to render public service and afford facilities for those who seek knowledge by collecting materials of scientific, artistic, ~~and~~ and cultural values.

RESOLUTION : Read and noted. The idea as underlined in Resolution No. 7 of the Museum Conference is agreed to. But, at present this scheme cannot be implemented as the Cantt. is not yet developed and evidently there are no materials obtainable worth keeping in a museum.

5. To consider the quotations received for the supply of night soil receptacles for the year 1955-56. Budget provision exists under Head F-9.

No The contract should be given to the contractor at the lowest rate of Rs 11/8/-, the lowest rate quoted, as his sample is made of heavy metal and is therefore approved. The contractor's letter dated 6th May 1955, is read and his offer is approved.

6. To consider plan showing the siting of the Cantonment Board Primary School.
